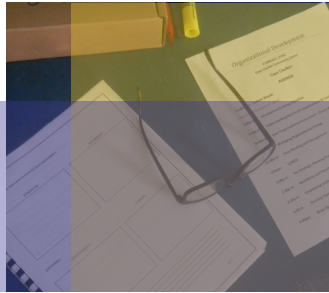

PACT makes available capacity building grants to eligible organizations and individuals with the aim of improving capacity in the natural and cultural resources, protected areas management, and community development fields.

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Carefully fill out the Environmental Fellowship Grant Application Form (PACT office or pact-belize.org) ensuring all questions are completed.
2. Drop off or mail to PACT before deadline as indicated in the “Call for Applications.”
3. PACT will inform you via email and regular mail the status of your application once finalized.

ENVIRONMENTAL FELLOWSHIP GRANTS

these are designed to provide financial assistance to dynamic and successful mid-career and/or senior professional Belizeans accepted to attend recognized institutions locally, regionally or internationally or distance learning programs to earn a Master’s degree

Eligibility Criteria:

- » Be a Belizean citizen and resident in Belize.
- » Be between 23 and 40 years of age.
- » Preferably have at least 2 years professional experience in the conservation field.
- » Be accepted in a graduate study program at a recognized institution within the specific fields of environmental law and policy, environmental economics, coastal and marine management, conservation biology, wildlife ecology and management, fisheries management, tropical ecology or any other programmes related to conservation.
- » Demonstrate co-financing capacity.
- » Demonstrate a minimum semester GPA of 3.5 on a 4 point scale or the equivalent.
- » Be able to demonstrate at an interview that they possess the personal qualities to benefit from their fellowship and use it to succeed in their chosen career.
- » Must have a clear idea how their fellowship will benefit Belize on completion.
- » Applicants must demonstrate the potential to rise to positions of leadership and influence upon completion of their studies. They need to demonstrate that they possess the personal, intellectual and interpersonal attributes reflecting this potential.
- » Commit to work in Belize for at least two years at the end of the study period.
