PACT awards capacity development grants to eligible organizations for formal, short term training and capacity building activities with the aim of strengthening human resource capacity for improved protected areas management.

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Carefully fill out the Individual Professional Development Grant Application Form (PACT office or pactbelize.org) ensuring all questions are completed.
2. Drop off or mail to PACT. In cases of training grants, application must be received at least six (6) weeks prior to training.
3. PACT will inform you via email and regular mail the status of your application once finalized.

INDIVIDUAL PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT GRANTS

are only awarded to eligible organizations that apply on behalf of their members of staff or Board of Directors and are not awarded to individuals

Eligibility Criteria:

- » The applicant organization should demonstrate cash counterpart contribution.
- » Activities should be short-term training courses, seminars, workshops and/or conferences to be attended locally, regionally and/or internationally.
- » Application should be submitted by an eligible organization on behalf of the individual staff member; in the case where the individual is a Board member or the Executive Director, the application must be signed by the Board Chairperson.
- » Budget should include only direct costs related to the activity (registration, travel, accommodation, etc.).
- » The individual should be a good-standing, permanent member of staff or Board of Directors.
- » The individual's current work and the proposed activity must help advance the mission of the organization.
- » Activities must be directly related to the individual's scope of work and build the institutional capacity of the organization by providing the individual with the knowledge and skills to advance his/her role in the conservation, preservation, enhancement and management of Belize's natural resources and/or protected areas.
- » The individual whom the grant is applied for should not have received a capacity development grant from PACT within the last 6 months.
- » The applicant organization should not have received two or more capacity development grants from PACT within the last PACT fiscal year.

grant budget: \$10,000 • project period: 6 months
