LARGE GRANTS

Under the Large Grants Program, prospective grantees develop proposals with direct contribution to the National Protected Areas System and its connectivity with other regional management regimes.

PLANNING GRANTS

Planning successful project proposals requires substantial preliminary work. Planning Grants will be made available for stakeholder consultations and problem analysis in project planning, conceptualization, design and formulation of a proposal for submission to PACT.

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Carefully fill out the Large Grant or Planning Grant Application Form (pactbelize.org) ensuring all questions are completed.
2. Drop off or mail to PACT. For Large Grants, drop off or mail the final proposal within one (1) month of request from PACT.
3. PACT will inform you via email and regular mail the status of your application once finalized.

LARGE GRANTS Eligibility Criteria:

- » A project concept must have been accepted by PACT prior to the development of the project proposal.
- » A minimum of 50% must come from sources other than PACT. This could be in-kind contribution, cash funding from other sources or a combination of both.
- » Large Grants are only awarded to organizations with an operational budget exceeding \$200,000 per annum. In the event that more than one organization partner in the submission of an application, the collective operational budget should still remain the same. Funding is awarded only for project concepts that have been accepted and to organizations who have rated successful in an organizational capacity assessment.
- » Refer to the Grants Application and Management Guide for additional criteria.

grant budget: \$200,001 - \$400,000 • project period: 2 years

PLANNING GRANTS Eligibility Criteria:

- » A project concept must have been accepted by PACT.
- » The total budget should include 50% cash counterpart contribution from the applicant.



grant budget: \$1,000 - \$5,000
