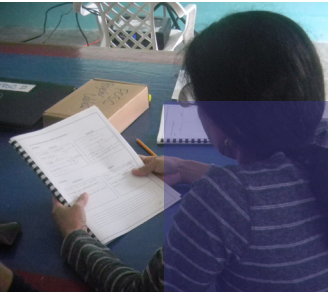

PACT awards capacity development grants to eligible organizations for formal, short term training and capacity building activities with the aim of strengthening human resource capacity for improved protected areas management.

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Carefully fill out the Local Workshop/ Seminar Implementation Grant Application Form (PACT office or pactbelize.org) ensuring all questions are completed.
2. Drop off or mail to PACT. In cases of training grants, application must be received at least six (6) weeks prior to training.
3. PACT will inform you via email and regular mail the status of your application once finalized.

LOCAL WORKSHOP/ SEMINAR IMPLEMENTATION GRANTS

are only awarded to eligible organizations that wish to plan and implement training workshops, seminars, conferences and other capacity building activities in Belize

Eligibility Criteria:

- » The applicant organization should demonstrate cash counterpart contribution.
- » Activities should be short-term training courses, seminars, workshops and/or conferences to be implemented locally.
- » Activities must be designed by the eligible organization and must provide targeted participants with the knowledge and skills to advance their role in the conservation, preservation, enhancement and management of Belize's natural resources and/or protected areas.
- » Activities should result in meaningful impact, involve a diverse group of stakeholders, and benefit more than one geographic area.
- » Budget should include only direct costs related to the activity (venue, accommodation, transportation, etc.).
- » Activities must be directly related to the applicant's and participants scope of work and build institutional capacities by providing participants with the knowledge and skills to advance their role in the conservation, preservation, enhancement and management of Belize's natural resources and/or protected areas.
- » The applicant organization should not have received two or more capacity development grants from PACT within the last PACT fiscal year.

grant budget: \$25,000 • project period: 6 months
