The Government of Belize, in collaboration with the World Bank (WB) is implementing the project entitled “**REDD+ Readiness Project**”. The objective of the REDD+ Readiness Project is to carry out Readiness Preparation through a participatory and inclusive process in order to strengthen Belize’s capacity to participate in future REDD+ carbon payment transactions. The REDD+ Readiness Project is being implemented by the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries, Forestry, the Environment, Sustainable Development and Immigration (MAFFESDI) through a dedicated REDD+ Coordination Unit (REDD+CU) with Fiduciary Management by the Protected Areas Conservation Trust (PACT).

Implementation of the **REDD+ Readiness Project** will be over a three (3) year period. The project has five (5) components:

- *Component 1: REDD+ Organization Framework, Consultation and Grievance Redress;*
- *Component 2: Preparation of REDD+ Strategy;*
- *Component 3: Development of a National Forest Reference Emission Level and a Forest Reference Level;*
- *Component 4: Design of National Forest Monitoring and Safeguards Systems;*
- *Component 5: Design of Monitoring and Evaluation Framework;*

REDD+ is seeking to recruit an Individual Consultant with the critical minimum requirements listed below:

- Minimum Master’s degree, preferably in forest management, environmental science, economics, or natural resource management or a discipline related to the project;
- Ten (10) years working experience in climate change issues including REDD+, forest/natural resources management, environmental management, and rural and social development;
- At least five (5) years of experience in leading large scale and multi-disciplinary development programmes/projects covering all aspects of programme/project cycle management including budgeting, administration, human resources, monitoring and evaluation, and reporting;
- Knowledge in GIS/remote sensing is an asset;
- Previous work experience on development programmes in developing countries (Latin American and/or Caribbean country experience is an advantage);
- Proven management experience including supervision of staff, consultants and coordination of programme/projects teams in a multi-disciplinary environment;
- Demonstrated knowledge of donor programme/project management practices and modalities;

- Experience working with governments in developing countries;
- Excellent computer skills including full working knowledge MS Office, and Internet;
- Proficiency in both oral and written English. Spanish would be an additional asset;

The expected start date for the Consultancy is Mid-August 2017. The successful candidate will be employed on a contractual basis which will be renewed annually, based upon satisfactory job performance. The Consultant will be housed within the MAFFESDI.
