



Entry guidelines for National Climate Change Youth Video Competition

How it works (please read carefully!)

Step 1.

Read carefully the ***Official Rules for the National Climate Change Youth Video Competition*** (attached Annex 1).

Step 2.

Create a three (3) minute video which should focus on one of two categories:

- 1) *Responsible production and consumption*: submit videos that showcase your activities that contribute to responsible production and consumption.
- 2) *Green and climate friendly jobs*: submit videos that showcase your activities that contribute to the creation of climate friendly jobs.

Step 3.

By 13th July, 2018

Fill out Entry Form (attached Annex 2) and
Submit your video on a storage device to the Office

Step 4.

The top two entries will be selected by a panel of seven judges. The first and second place winners will be notified of their win on July 20th, 2018.

Prizes:

Prizes will be given to the top two selected video entrants, which will include cash prizes and certificates on August 3, 2018 at an event closing ceremony. In addition, the first and second place videos will be submitted to the UNFCCC as Belize's submission to the Global Youth Video Competition on Climate Change 2018.
